## The Call of Moses

### 3:1 to 4:17



One thing **God knew** was that it was time to raise up a deliverer - **Moshe**. Accordingly, the narrative now focuses on that single man. **Exodus 2** has shown us that **God** had already begun to act upon **Isra'el's** grim circumstances by rising up a deliverer in Pharaoh's court. That deliverer was **Moses** and **he** was forced to flee to **Midian** for a further period of preparation because the deliverance of **the Hebrews** from **Egypt** was about to happen. **God** was clearly at work behind the scenes, guiding and directing everything for **His** purposes. The next step in the exodus of **Isra'el** now occurs, the call and commissioning of **Moses**.<sup>36</sup> **ADONAI** knew that **he** was ready, although **Moses** wasn't quite so sure.
