Men and Women in Worship 11:2 to 14:40



The theme of personal **freedom in Messiah** exercised without regard for the needs of others or **the glory of God**, which characterized the issue about **eating food sacrificed to idols (to see link click Bj - Concerning Our Freedom in Messiah)** seems no less a part of this section which deals with practices affecting the congregation of the church at **Corinth**. Here too, **Paul** responded to **the Corinthians** spirit of self-indulgence by stressing the principle of **glorifying God** and building up each other in true fellowship. Like book-ends, **Paul** begins (see **By - Head Coverings in Worship**) and ends **his** discussion of **freedom in Messiah** as it pertained to **worship** (see **Dp - Order in Public Worship: Wives in public worship**) with remarks directed primarily at the behavior of the **Corinthian women** during public **worship** on Sunday morning.
