Jesus' Acceptance in Samaria

John 4: 1-42



The brief ministry of **Yeshua** in **Samaria**, where **He** stopped just two days on **His** way to **Galilee**, is especially significant, in that **He** defined **His** attitude toward that despised people. This is the first of four separate occasions we see **Jesus** ministering to Gentiles in the gospels. The **Jews** hated **the Samaritans**, but, **Messiah** saw them in a different light. **His** work there is also a fine example of missionary **method** and policy. **He** won an individual first, a **Samaritan woman by Jacob's well**, thus gaining a hearing in the city of **Sychar**.³⁵²
