## Messiah, the Perfect Sacrifice

10: 1-18

The writer to the **Hebrews** has made his case. **God's** revelation in **Yeshua** is **better** to that given through **Moshe**. **Jesus' High Priesthood** is **better** than that of the Levitical priesthood. The Dispensation of Grace that **Messiah** administers is **better** than the Dispensation of the Torah. As our **High Priest**, **Christ** ministers in **the heavenly Tabernacle**, while Isra'el's priest ministered in an **earthly Tabernacle**, a mere copy and **shadow** of the true one. And **the Lord's sacrifice of Himself** has accomplished what **the blood of bulls and goats** could never do. But like a good attorney, as the writer is about to move on to the lifestyle of the believer, he closes this section of the book by going over key points once again. If what we read in **Hebrews 10:1-18** sounds familiar, it's because it is familiar. But it's also vital. And the writer wants to be sure there's no mistake about the core truth's he's taught. After all, our life depends on them.<sup>249</sup>
