Sword, Famine, and Drought Jeremiah 14:1 to 15:21

608 BC During the eleven-year reign of Jehoiakim



The connection between **drought** and the enemy is very clear in this section. It encompasses a variety of speakers and audiences. But it begins with a description of **the drought** (**to see link click Cj - Judah's Terrible Drought**) and ends with a description of defeat in battle (see Cl - You Have Rejected Me, I am Tired of Relenting), followed by **Jeremiah's** fourth complaint (see Cm - Woe to Me, Mother, That You Gave Me Birth). In between we hear of **sword**, famine, and drought (14:12).
