## **Moses and Jethro**

**18: 1-27** 



Before we arrive at **Mount Sinai** and the culminating scene of the exodus, the author records a story of **Jethro's** visit to **Moshe**. **His** visit contrasts with the Amalekite conflict. The Amalekites came to fight, while **Jethro** sought knowledge. With one there was war, with the other mediating for peace; with one, **Moses' hands** grew tired, and with the other **his** work grew too heavy. There are three sections to this chapter: the arrival of **Jethro** (18:1-12), the appointment of **judges** (18:13-26), and the return of **Jethro** to **Midian** (18:27). As we come to the close of this chapter, we, like **the Israelites**, are prepared to approach **God** at **Mount Sinai**.<sup>327</sup>
