The Revelation at Mount Sinai **19:1 to 40:38**



We have now come to the fourth and last of the major sections of the book of **Exodus**. It contains **twenty-two** of the **forty chapters** in the book, and it is longer than the first three sections put together. Although some of it is repetitive (**35:4** to **38:20**, and **39:1-31**, repeating earlier sections of the book sometimes almost word for word); it contains vital teaching about **God's** blueprint for living as seen in the Ten Commandments and about **Christ** as seen in **the Tabernacle**.

The Israelites arrived at **Mount Sinai** where **they** remained throughout the rest of the events recorded in **Exodus 19:1** to **Numbers 10:10**. **They** camped in front of **Mount Sinai** for eleven months and six days, from the fifteenth day of **the third month** of their first year of traveling, to **the twentieth day of the second month of the second year** of traveling (**Numbers 10:11**). There, **Moshe** received **the Torah** from **ADONAI** with its many instructions for worship for **the people** that **YHVH** had redeemed.³⁴⁰
