## **The Controversy Over King Messiah**



Pharisaic Judaism believed that **the Oral Law** (**to see link click <u>Ei</u> - The Oral Law**) was equal to, or even slightly greater than, the 613 commandments written by the human author Moses in the Torah. Thus, the Great Sanhedrin (see <u>Lg</u> - The Great Sanhedrin), or the Jewish Supreme Court rejected Jesus as **the Messiah** at that time. Once **He** was rejected, the focus of **His** ministry changed (see <u>En</u> - Four Drastic Changes in Christ's Ministry).
