

Revelation After the Rejection of King Messiah

The rejection of the Prophet from Galilee was the turning point in His ministry. King Messiah had authenticated His authority by the miracles only the Expected One could perform: Then will the eyes of the blind be opened and the ears of the deaf unstopped. Then the lame leap like a deer, and the mute tongue shout for joy (Isaiah 35:5-6a). But growing opposition to the Kosher King climaxed when the Jewish Supreme Court (see Lg - The Great Sanhedrin) concluded that the Son of God was demon possessed (see Ek - It is only by Beelzebub, the Prince of Demons, that This Fellow Drives Out Demons). While their full rejection and execution of Him did not occur until later, the die was cast. Thus, the Meshiach turned His attention to His talmidim and began to teach along different lines.
