The Sanctuary of the Tabernacle Chapters 25, 26, 30, 36, 37 and Leviticus 24:2-9



In our journey through **the Tabernacle**, we have come from the camp of **Isra'el**, in through the gate, past the bronze altar and bronze basin, and now, we come to **the Sanctuary** that contained the Sh'khinah glory, the very presence of **God**. **The Sanctuary** was covered with four successive sets of **curtains** made of four progressively stronger materials from the inside out: **linen (26:1-6)**, **goat hair (26:7-13)**, **ram skins (26:14)** and **the hides of sea cows (26:14)**. One standing in the courtyard could see only the outer covering of **the hides of sea cows**; however, the priests on the inside of **the Sanctuary** could see only the beautiful **curtains of finely twisted linen** with figures of **cherubim** embroidered on it in **blue**, **purple and scarlet**.
